Dear WOAHP delegates,

In the working document of the Terrestrial Animal Health Standards Commission (page 18, Chapter 7.1, Article 7.1.2), Proposal 5 states: **“The use of animals [...] for cultural and entertainment purposes contributes to the well-being of people.”**

This phrasing is deeply problematic, as it risks legitimizing cruel practices such as **bullfighting (also known as CORRIDA)**, a form of cultural entertainment still practiced in the South of France and some other European and Latin American countries. **Such activities inherently involve animal suffering, which directly contradicts the principles of animal welfare.**

To uphold WOAHP's commitment to ethical animal treatment, we respectfully call on you to:

Reject Proposal 5 in its current form and reaffirm that no form of animal suffering can be justified **by cultural tradition.**
